Several of these components are well-known carcinogens, and others have a wide range of immediate and long-term toxic effect on vital organs. The total health effect of whatever mix is inside a particular product is unknown. Common labeling terms are too general to give us any idea of the actual contents.

Recently, the United States Architectural and Transportation Barriers Compliance Board adopted a fragrance-free public meeting policy. Similar policies are being enacted all over the world, due to people's intolerance to fragranced products. Now is the time to take measures insuring access to public facilities by removing the fragrance and scent-emitting devices.



systems are space saving, turnkey, fully automatic (no need to have extra personnel). They produce a small amount of non-leachable solid waste and result in clean, odor free water that can be re-used/recycled. The advantages are a stand alone system or it can be used in conjunction with existing oil water separators and recycling equipment that may not be living up to your expectations.

SECTION 508 Technology Accessibility Standards

Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, requires that when Federal agencies develop, procure, maintain or use electronic and information technology, individuals with disabilities have access to and use of the information and data that is comparable to the access and use by individuals without disabilities.

The Architectural and Transportation Barriers Compliance Board (Access Board) developed and issued standards on December 21, 2000, that meet statutory requirements. These standards will be incorporated into the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) and apply only to electronic and information technology that is commercially available (e.g., telecommunications products; video and multimedia products; self contained, closed products; desktop and portable computers and copiers etc.) The standards for Section 508 became enforceable on June 21, 2001.

The Office and Scientific Equipment Center recently amended RFP covering Federal Supply Schedule 36, "Office, Imaging and Document Solutions" (Special Item Number 51-501, Needs Assessment and Analysis), to specifically allow for contract coverage for Section 508 compliance assessment services. The objective is to offer help to those Federal agencies that do not have the expertise to assess their compliance with the Section 508 Technology Accessibility Standards.

Contract coverage for this new service is expected by mid to late summer 2001.


