(STANDARDIZED TRUCKS AVAILABLE NOW)**



The Automotive Division's STAN program is changing from a requirements type procurement to becoming a multiple award schedule type procurement under Vehicular Multiple Award Schedule 23 V. The STAN program covers medium and heavy trucks under the current Federal Standard 794 for gross vehicle weight ratings of 21,000 to 35,000 lbs., and Federal Standard 807 for gross vehicle weight ratings of 43,000 to 66,000 lbs.

The balance of the Automotive Division's CATHY Program, which covers Low-Boy and Platform trailers will soon be merged under Vehicular Multiple Award Schedule (VMAS) 23 V. Currently VMAS covers the Van Type, Enclosed Concession & Mobile Sound Shell Stage trailers.

SIN 023-101 will be expanded to include contracts for Lowboy and Platform Trailers. The projected timeframe for CATHY to be merged is late summer, at which time all trailers will be available under Schedule 23 V.

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ORDER VEHICLES ON-LINE



The Office of Vehicle Acquisition and Leasing Services is happy to announce that the on-line ordering capability of AutoChoice is now available for your vehicle acquisition needs at: fss.gsa.gov/vehicles/buying.

For those of you who may be unfamiliar with the program, AutoChoice is an on-line program which allows customers to choose and configure vehicle models and compare contract prices from General Motors, Ford, DaimlerChrysler and Honda. This program allows you to view base prices as well as prices for equipment options. AutoChoice will calculate the prices for the selected vehicles and give you a price summary, including the GSA 1% surcharge. Miles per gallon fuel ratings are also displayed. You can now select the best value to meet your agency's mission and send your order directly to the Automotive Division using AutoChoice. If you

would like to view the AutoChoice web site, please go to fss.gsa.gov/vehicles/buying then click on the AutoChoice button. The first time you use the program you will need to register as a new user. In addition to configuring and pricing the vehicles that provide the best value, you can add your choice(s) to the "Garage" and place your order with GSA electronically.

After registering in AutoChoice, your basic authorization level will allow you to place orders in the "Garage" for your agency. Users who have authority to send orders to GSA must contact us to increase their authorization level.
