

## Federal Supply Schedule 751 Leasing of Automobiles and Light Trucks

### ALTERNATIVE FUEL VEHICLES AVAILABLE FOR LEASE

GSA's Federal Supply Schedule 751 – Leasing of Automobiles and Light Trucks now has Alternative Fuel Vehicles (AFVs) available for lease. This new schedule offers sedans, SUVs, vans and light trucks. All vehicles offered are current model year and are equipped in accordance with the applicable Federal Vehicle Standard.

- Leasing options range from 3 to 36 months
- Leases do not include maintenance
- All of the vehicles ordered under this Schedule will be delivered within 90 to 120 days after receipt of order
- Agencies work directly with the chosen contractor issuing and administrating their own delivery orders

This leasing schedule is a separate program from GSA's Fleet Management Leasing Program.



The Office of Vehicle Acquisition and Leasing Services can assist customer agencies in meeting the mandates of Executive Order 13149, which supercedes Executive Order 13031, requiring federal agencies to acquire alternative fuel vehicles. The Automotive Division's DAVE (Drive Alternative fuel Vehicles Easily) offers

alternative fueled sedans, pickup trucks, buses, vans, medium duty delivery trucks and specialty vehicles.

The types of alternative fuel vehicles (AFVs) currently available are: flexible fuel (designed to operate on alcohol, gasoline or a combination of both), bi-fuel (can run on either alternative or conventional fuel) and dedicated (runs on one fuel only).

The alternative motor fuels available are electricity, ethanol, natural gas and propane. We have established contracts with the major manufacturers.
