Contractor

State and local governments can also benefit from the speed and savings of authorized GSA programs.

This placard indicates that you are a GSA Schedule contractor and have agreed to allow state and local governments to purchase via your GSA Schedule contract under one or more of the following programs:

Cooperative Purchasing Program

State and local governments may purchase a variety of information technology (IT) from Schedule 70 and the IT Special Item Numbers (SINs) on the Consolidated Schedule as well as law enforcement and security products and services from Schedule 84.

Disaster Recovery Purchasing Program

State and local governments may purchase products and services to be used to facilitate recovery from a major disaster, terrorism or nuclear, biological, chemical or radiological attack, from approved contractors under ALL Federal Supply Schedules.

1122 Program

State and units of local governments, via designated State Points of Contact (SPOC), may purchase law enforcement equipment and motor vehicles through Federal procurement channels, provided the purchase is used in the performance of counterdrug activities.

Public Health Emergencies (PHE)

State, local, territorial and tribal governments may purchase products and services from all Federal Supply Schedules, when expending federal grants funds in response to Public Health Emergencies (PHEs) declared by the Secretary of Health and Human Services under section 319 of the Public Health Services Act.
