Green Products

GSA helps customer agencies meet environmental requirements by offering federal agencies thousands of green products. There are two ways you can buy green products from GSA:

- **GSA Advantage!®'s Environmental Aisle** offers thousands of individual green products to help federal agencies meet their unique needs.
- **GSA Global Supply™** is a one-stop source for requisition-based ordering that provides comprehensive, environmentally, compliant solutions. Agencies who order through GSA Global Supply are assured regulatory compliance, a single bill and global delivery from a government source.

Green Services

Through GSA's Multiple Awards Schedules (GSA MAS) program, your agency can contract with environmental-services providers to plan for strategic sustainability performance, manage greenhouse gases, develop sustainable buildings, manage water efficiently, maintain green fleets and transportation, prevent pollution, and reduce waste. These Schedules include:

- Environmental Services (GSA MAS 899) — Hire industry experts to meet your agency's environmental requirements in the areas of pollution prevention, HAZMAT, electronics stewardship, and others, including:
 - Environmental consulting;
 - Environmental management training;
 - Materials and waste recycling and disposal;
 - Geographic information systems services; and
 - Remediation and reclamation.
- Facilities Maintenance and Management (GSA MAS 03FAC) — Maintain and manage greener facilities with comprehensive energy-management, water-conservation and support services, including:
 - Building commissioning;
 - Energy audits;
 - Energy-management planning and strategies;
 - Energy-program support;
 - Innovations in energy;
 - Introduction of new services;
 - Metering services;
 - Resource-efficiency management;
 - Training on energy management; and
 - Water conservation.
- Total Solutions for Law Enforcement, Security, Facilities Management, Fire, Rescue, Clothing, Marine Craft and Emergency/Disaster Response (GSA MAS 84) — Total solutions, including:
 - Facility management;
 - Facility and energy solutions, including energy-saving performance contracts; and
 - Management systems.



Green Vehicles

To meet environmental standards, GSA offers agencies new, more fuel-efficient vehicles that provide long-term environmental benefits and save taxpayers' money. You can buy these vehicles from GSA AutoChoice, lease them from GSA Fleet, or use GSA Schedules to lease automobiles and light trucks directly from automotive vendors. These green offerings include:

- Alternative fuel vehicles (AFVs), and
- Biodiesel fuels.

Other Tools to Help Agencies Go Green

Track and Report Environmental Spending

With GSA's Advantage Spend Analysis Program (ASAP), agencies can meet Office of Federal Procurement Policy (OFPP) and Office of Federal Environmental Executive (OFEE) requirements by tracking monies spent on environmental products purchased through GSA *Advantage!*®. Customers must be registered with the GSA *Advantage!*® website to access this tool.

Comprehensive Professional Energy Services Blanket Purchase Agreements

GSA's Comprehensive Professional Energy Services Blanket Purchase Agreements (CPES BPAs) help agencies meet recurring energy, greenhouse-gas, and water-conservation needs using a streamlined acquisition process. By utilizing this BPA, agencies get discounts, save administration time and reduce paperwork.

GSAXcess®: Reuse is Recycling

GSA's Personal Property Management can help your agency dispose of personal property no longer required to perform your mission. Agencies declare excess property to GSA, who records, tracks and donates or sells the property to federal, state, or local governments, eligible organizations, and citizens, minimizing waste going into the nation's landfills and saving taxpayers' money.

GSAXcess is GSA's online tool that provides our customers an electronic means of reporting excess personal property to GSA, as well as searching and selecting excess personal property to be acquired.

By using GSAXcess, customers seeking property can avoid the cost of new procurements by acquiring items that have been reported as excess by other federal agencies. GSAXcess is available only to federal agencies, state agencies and authorized non-federal recipients. Agencies may screen GSA's worldwide inventory and may request property for transfer by selecting specific items.

GSA Carbon Footprint Tool

GSA has developed the GSA Carbon Footprint Tool to assist agencies with managing their greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions, as required by Executive Order 13514. This tool can assist you with a broad range of tasks, including:

- Calculation of an agency's GHG baseline, broken down by the different scopes;
- Assistance with developing GHG-reduction targets;
- Compilation of a building-by-building GHG emissions inventory; and
- Preparation for reporting emissions to the Department of Energy's GHG-reporting portal.
