

# What's New in Transportation, Delivery and Relocation Solutions (TDRS) Schedule 48



The **Transportation, Delivery and Relocation Solutions (TDRS), Schedule 48**, offers customer agencies flexibility, cost and time savings, peace of mind and control.

New to the Schedule price list is the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) SmartWay Transport Partnership icon. Look for it and know you will be selecting a sustainable and energy-efficient transportation provider.



The SmartWay icon will inform both the transportation services industry and our federal agency customers that Schedule 48 vendors are in support of Executive Order 13514; Federal Leadership in Environmental, Energy and Economic Performance. Our federal agency customers will also be able to use these vendor partners to show they are complying with the Executive Order 13514.

The following Schedule 48 services may include environmentally sustainable options designed through partnering with the SmartWay Program. The SmartWay program encompasses both SmartWay Partners and Affiliates as well as certification of light-duty vehicles to

identify cleaner, more fuel efficient (passenger) cars and trucks. These options may reduce the impact on the environment in the areas of fuel consumption and greenhouse gas and air toxics emissions.

**Ground Passenger Transportation Services, Special Item Number (SIN) 411-1**, provides all services necessary to provide passenger shuttle services utilizing vans, motor coaches (buses) or limousines for both scheduled and unscheduled routes. Services are available for single or multiple passenger shuttle transportation between and among buildings, driver services, airport transport and VIP transport within or between cities.

The **Rental Supplemental Vehicle Program (RSVP), SIN 411-2**, provides rental vehicles to augment federal fleets and other vehicles for employees on non-temporary duty travel. RSVP allows agencies to rent vehicles for up to 120 days at one time, twice as long as offered in 2011. This longer rental period will reduce the workload of government customers and allow suppliers to rent vehicles for longer periods of time without contract or task order interruption. And, coming soon to Schedule 48, look for our SIN specifically for temporary duty travel Car Rental 411-2 TDY.



**Express Small Package and Express Heavyweight Delivery Services, SIN 451-1**, offers commercial delivery services for Express Same Day, Next Day, Two Day and Three Day delivery of extremely urgent letters, small packages and heavyweight shipments, including any accessorial services offered to the general public. Vendors may offer any combination of days or weight ranges for either the Express Small Package or the Express Heavyweight Delivery Services.

Vendors part of **New Services, SIN 451-99**, may offer new or improved services, including medical and custom critical delivery services, storage, freight transportations services, refrigerated delivery and other specialized services. The vendor may also perform a new task or procedure not currently available under any GSA Schedule.

**Ground Small Package Delivery Services, SIN 451-2**, offers ground day-definite delivery of small package shipments, including any accessorial services offered to the general public.

Vendors in **Move Management Services (CHAMP), SIN 653-7**, can provide a total package of move management services, including transferee entitlement and pre-move counseling, carrier selection, preparation of bills of lading, shipment booking, service performance and prepayment of audits, claims preparation assistance and on-site quality control.

**Office Relocation Services, SIN 653-8**, offers a full range of services to remove existing office furniture, equipment and related supplies from the existing location, transport the items to the new location and place them according to the direction of the federal agency. Services include but are not limited to pre-move planning, relocation plan designing, providing packaging materials, packing/crating, loading/unloading, delivery and setup.

**Long-Term Lodging, SIN 653-9**, is designed for lodging needs of 30 days or more. It includes apartment- or condominium-type properties that may be furnished with the home amenities you're used to.
