

## DRIVE INTO FY 2001



The start of the new fiscal year is upon us. The Office of Vehicle Acquisition and Leasing Services' Automotive Division is geared up and ready to take your orders for the Model Year 2001 sedan and light truck vehicles.

Coverage includes a full range of vehicles under multi-vendor contracts with DaimlerChrysler Corporation, Ford Motor Company and General Motors Corporation. Product availability includes a broad range of subcompact, compact, midsize and full size sedans. Light trucks are available in a wide range of sport utility vehicles, vans, compact/full size pickup trucks with regular or extended cabs, cab and chassis, dump, stake and service trucks. Pricing will be available for all items as offered by the manufacturers at the time of renewal.

Be on the lookout for major changes in the 2001 edition of the Federal Vehicle Standards. Tables have been realigned and our vehicle selection has increased for sedans and light trucks. We have also added several new option codes.

To assist customer agencies in meeting the mandates of the Energy Policy Act of 1992 (EPACT), we will again be offering a variety of sedans, light trucks, medium/heavy trucks, and buses powered by ethanol (E85), compressed natural gas (CNG), liquid natural gas (LNG), liquid propane gas (LPG) and electricity. These vehicles are available in dedicated, bi-fuel and flexible fuel configurations under our **DAVE** (Drive Alternative fuel Vehicles Easily) Program. For a complete listing please contact the Automotive Division.

Under **Federal Standard 122**, please note the following:

- **Table I Subcompact Sedans** – Standard Item Number 8C will now include the Saturn (new product line – available in limited quantities).
- **Table II Compact Sedan** – The Ford Contour will not be available. As a result, there will be no Ford product available in this size.
- **Table III Midsize Sedan** – The DaimlerChrysler 300M has been added.

- **Table V Subcompact Station Wagon** – Standard Item Number 13B has been changed to Item 12A representing a new product line, Saturn, available in limited quantities.
- **Table VI Compact Station Wagon** – Standard Item Number 14C has been changed to Standard Item Number 13B representing a new product line, Saturn LW, available in limited quantities.
- **New Table VII Midsize Station Wagon** has been added which covers the Ford Taurus, Standard Item Number 14C.

- **Table XI Full Size Crew Cab reflecting new Standard Item Numbers (\*indicates sole source)**
  - \*Standard Item Number 50 (4 x 2) Ford F150 Crew Cab
  - \*Standard Item Number 55 (4 x 4) Ford F150 Crew Cab
- **Table XVI Service Utility Regular Cab**, Standard Item Number 81 has been deleted from the Federal Vehicle Standard as there is not an item that will meet the required payload capacity.
- **Table XVII Service Utility Regular Cab**, Standard Item Number 81C has been deleted from the Federal Vehicle Standard as there is not an item that will meet the required payload capacity.
- **Table XXIV Delivery Van**, The description for Standard Item Numbers 92, 94A and 94B has been changed to reflect a cut-a-way cab and chassis with body options. Please take note that the commercial delivery van body option codes DVAL (commercial delivery van body) and DVS (commercial utility body with superstructure) are now reflected as below the line options.

**Note: When selecting your new 2001 model year vehicles, carefully check tables and item numbers. Many of the item numbers have been changed and now represent different vehicles from the previous Federal Vehicle Standards.**

## MARK! (MODERN AMBULANCES READY KWIK)



The Automotive Division's **MARK** (Modern Ambulances Ready **Kwik**) Program is available to meet your medical needs. MARK offers five ambulances with state-of-the-art equipment in styles that will meet your agency requirements. Current models have a patient capacity of two (with primary patient on cot, secondary patient on squad bench) or four (with primary patient on cot and three ambulatory patients on squad bench). Designs are available for light duty rescue and extreme duty ambulance usage. The MARK Program offers three types of models: a conventional cab/chassis with an all aluminum modular body, a van with an extended roof, and a van cutaway chassis with an all-aluminum modular body.

Contract coverage is currently with Wheeled Coach under contract number GS-30F-97163. The average delivery time ranges from 90 to 120 days depending on the type and model you choose. Selected optional equipment is available to meet your agency needs.
